

## **FIRA ROBO-WORLD CUP TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

In these Terms and Conditions the term “Organiser” means University of Bristol and University of the West of England, Bristol

1. The Team\* agrees to comply with the regulations of FIRA (as may be updated from time to time) in relation to the events for which the Team has entered, the current version of which is [where are the regulations?]

If applicable, we hereby irrevocably and unconditionally waive any of our moral rights arising under Parts I and II of the Copyright Designs and Patents Act 1988 (“CPDA”) and performers' non-property rights arising under Part II of the CDPA and any similar laws of any jurisdiction in favour of the Organiser and all its licensees.
